What's an Ultreya?

An Ultreya, (pronounced *ull-tray'-uh*) is **an enjoyably prayerful gathering of Christians** (or aspiring Christians) --- including area parishioners, visitors and guests -- all of whom are warmly welcomed to attend a beautiful liturgy and a sharing of faith experiences.

Many of those in attendance will have “lived” a special, spiritual weekend, known as Cursillo -- (pronounced *ker-see'-o*) -- a Spanish term, meaning **“A mini-course in Christianity.”**

Others who will attend are merely curious about Cursillo – because of all the good things that they've heard from people, as well as encouraging invitations for them to attend. The setting is relaxed and the sharing is confidential. A wonderful “fourth day” speaker has been invited to share his spiritual journey – contrasting his life before and since he lived his own Cursillo.
